



Code of Student Conduct & Discipline Policy

Dear Parents,

To ensure a safe, respectful, and disciplined learning environment, we request you to review the following guidelines with your child.

Students are expected to:

- Foster a positive, supportive, and respectful school environment.
- Follow school rules and discipline policies at all times.
- Participate actively in school activities.
- Be mindful of their conduct and its impact on others.
- Contribute ideas for improving school discipline and climate.

General Rules & Regulations

- Respect school staff and peers at all times.
- Avoid damaging school property; compensation will be required for any damage caused.
- Maintain cleanliness; littering is strictly prohibited.
- Misconduct such as irregular attendance,, loitering, or disrespect will result in disciplinary action.
- Bullying or ragging will lead to strict disciplinary review and possible expulsion.
- English is the medium of instruction and must be used for communication.
- Carrying the school ID card daily is mandatory.
- Valuables, including expensive jewellery and electronic items, should not be brought to school.
- Smoking, drug use, or influencing others in such activities will result in immediate expulsion.
- Students under 14 are not permitted to create social media accounts.

Discipline & Online Conduct

- Students must not engage in cyberbullying, harassment, or share inappropriate content online.
- Violation of these rules will lead to disciplinary action, including suspension or expulsion.

Birthday Policy

- Only toffees or chocolates (₹10 per item) may be distributed. No expensive gifts allowed.
- Dress Code: Pre-Primary to Grade V students may wear casual but appropriate attire. Grade 6 and above must wear the school uniform.
- No cake cutting or food distribution is permitted in school.

NOTE: The parents are requested to not to send any gifts on any occasions for the school staff.
